### Internet eXchange Points (IXPs) are:


 a network facility that enables the interconnection of more than two independent Autonomous Systems to facilitate the exchange of Internet traffic.

• IXPs are considered core Internet infrastructure and carry a growing percentage of the world's Internet traffic.

### Albania:

- ISP-rich environment (51 ASNs)
- No neutral IXP

   (one non-neutral IX managed by the incumbent)

### Where does local Albanian traffic go?

- Shkodër to Tirana: 70 km

- RTT: 108.7 ms







# First International Carrier

EXA is executing a targeted growth strategy to invest capital in new infrastructure in Southeast Europe

Several projects have been approved and are currently in implementation phase:

- New transport route between Crotone in Italy and Preveza in Greece, with extensions to Athens and Thessaloniki.
- Trans Adriatic Express. TAE is a seamless fiber backbone between the Greek/Turkish border and Marseille, connecting the major data centers of Southeast Europe. Thessaloniki and Athens are amongst the cities that will be connected to TAE.
- New transport route between Belgrade and Milan with new PoP in Zagreb.






